## Vision

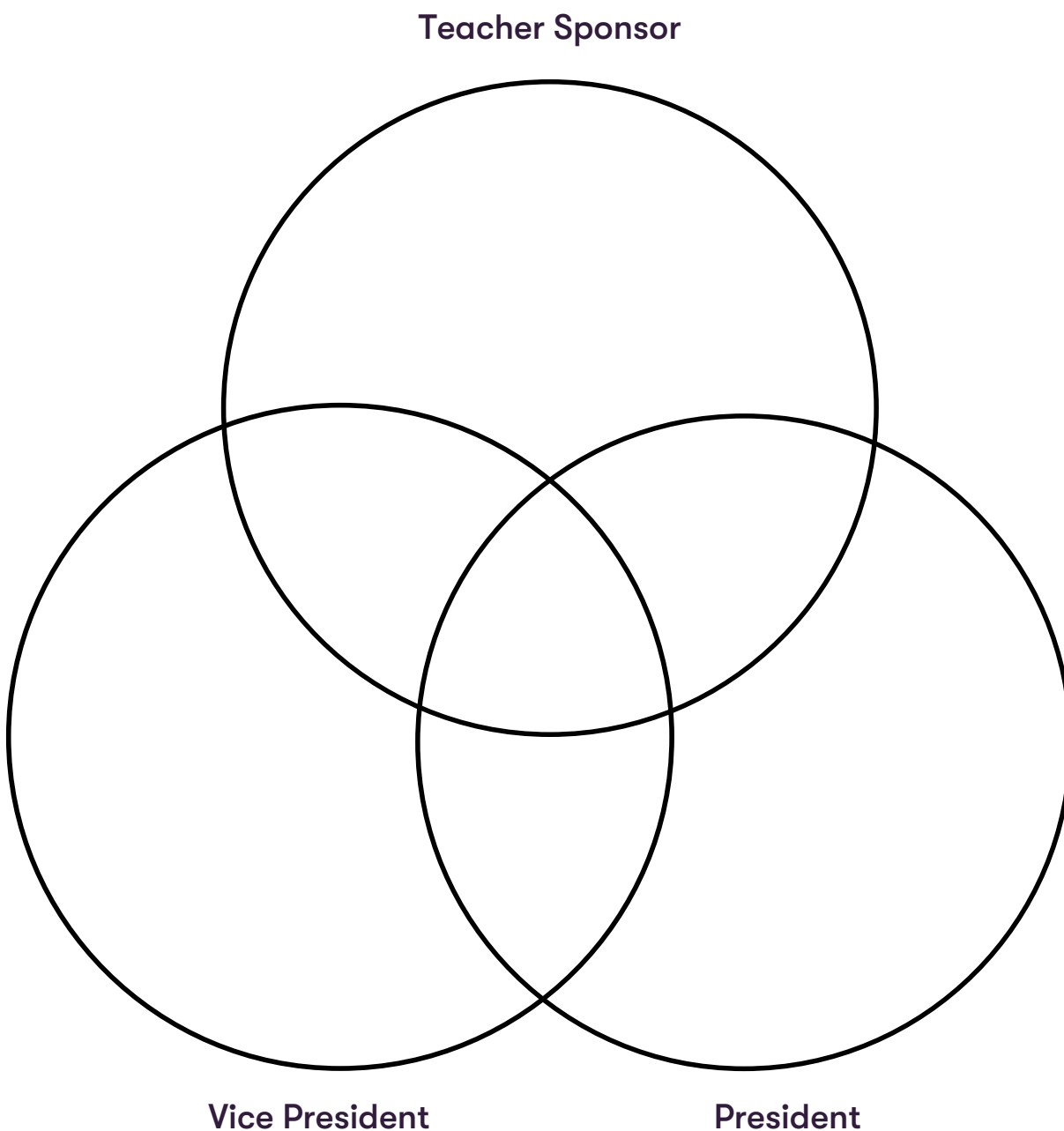
